
The past and future minor sins of one who makes a thorough wudu (i.e, by washing all limbs completely) on a cold day will be forgiven.



It is mustahab (preferable) to do masah (wipe with wet fingers) on the nape of the neck. One who makes masah on the nape will - Insha Allah be saved from severe thirst and from being shackled on the day of Qiyamah.

This Ummah will be distinguished from the rest of mankind by the shine of the limbs washed during wudu. Rasulullah (sallallahu'alayhi wasallam) therefore encouraged:

"those who can increase the shine should do so."

i.e. by washing extra.
